



What to Bring:

- Bible
- Pen and paper
- Sledding clothes
- Warm winter clothes
 - NO tank tops, tube tops, shorts, or other summer wear will be permitted at any time.
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Toiletries (Bathroom Stuff)
- Towel (Wash cloth if you use one)
- Money (For snacks and offering)

What NOT to Bring:

- iPods, iPads, electronic gaming devices, cell phones, computers, or any other distracting item. (there is not reception anyway)
- Any kind of weapon or dangerous item (guns, knives, throwing stars, brass knuckles, matches, lighters, flame throwers, fireworks, ect...)
- Anything illegal (drugs, alcohol, prescription drugs, pornography, ect...)
